Learning Themes at the start of the Autumn Term

Nursery have been looking out for signs of Autumn as well as enjoying sharing who is in their family. They are also busy planting bulbs and learning about what plants need to grow.

Reception's Enquiry theme is 'Marvellous Me' and the children are learning all about themselves, their families. They are also learning to identify a range of emotions and developing friendships and social skills along the way.

Year One's Enquiry theme is 'What Is Cool About Our School?' They are learning about schools in the past and how they have changed over time. They will explore maps and draw simple routes within school and on our school playground. From this they can then identify human and physical features of our school site. The end of the unit of work will include a walk to explore the junior school site to compare it to our school.

Year Two are learning about 'Our Blue Planet'. We have learned some new geographical language such as 'northern' and 'southern hemisphere'. We've also looked at how groups of countries form areas of land called continents.

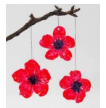
