## Forest School

We are so fortunate to have our Forest School within our school site and outdoor learning is a vital part of our curriculum. It is looking particularly beautiful at the moment with the emerging Autumn colours and a lot of hard work by Mrs Payne, our Assistant Head and Forest School Lead. She has revamped several of the areas to provide exciting and inviting places for children to explore.

Forest School provides opportunities for children to develop independent play and problem solving techniques as well as a place to learn new skills and apply their learning in a practical, real life setting.

Most children spend an extended session in Forest School every fortnight (but some classes, such as our Reception classes at the moment) are going every week to build personal and social skills and practise key gross motor skills.
