#### Key message

Due to extreme pressures across emergency departments, please only attend the A&E if you're experiencing a life-threatening emergency. For help with minor healthcare needs, try these alternative options:

- Urgent Treatment Centres (UTCs): visit UTCs for support with common injuries and illnesses
- Pharmacy First: visit your [local pharmacy](#) for advice, guidance, and medication for common conditions
- NHS 111: call 111 or visit [111.nhs.uk](http://111.nhs.uk) for urgent, non-life-threatening medical advice 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- GP practice: call or book an appointment with your GP
