Learning Next Term...

Nursery will be enjoying the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. They will be learning to thread, to talk about how you can move in big giant steps and to play games and build models around the story. Families can support their child's learning by repeated counting to 20, turn taking when playing games and comparing big giant steps with their smaller ones.



Reception will be reading the story of The Little Red Hen and learning about the different parts that make up a story sequence. They will also be planning a trip to a farm where they can meet the animals from the story and experience the sights, sounds and smells of a farm for themselves! Families can support Reception children in their learning by practising the different ways to make 10, talking about the different characters in books they share and discussing what animals live on a farm and what they need to stay healthy.



Year One are going to be busy learning about their local area and then comparing it to a very different part of the world where penguins live. You can support your child's learning by looking at maps of our local area, pointing out local landmarks and highlighting the important role Longbridge had in car production for many years. Children also need to practise counting in 2s to 24, 5s to 60 and 10s to above 100.



Year Two will be learning about where our food comes from and what constitutes a balanced diet and a healthy lifestyle. You can get your child's learning off to a good start by reading food labels with them and talking about air miles and sharing a map of the world to see where food originates from. Children will also be learning about measure so using a ruler, tape measure or sat nav over the holidays will help prepare your child for next term.
