Recalling and Using Knowledge

Challenge your child to explain something they have been learning about.....

Nursery— ask your child about **positional language** such as 'under',' over', 'between', 'next', 'to', 'in', 'front of', 'behind', 'in', 'out' and 'on'.

Reception— ask your child to help you **share quantities** to 20 into groups of 2, 5 and 10 using everyday objects from counters, toys, pebbles, coins, potatoes... anything that's available.

Year One— Ask your child to explain **how chocolate is made** and where it comes from.

Year Two— Ask your child to be your 'time keeper' and get the to explain how to tell the time on an analogue and a digital clock?

Being able to recall learning and explain it to someone else is a really important, and quite tricky skill to master!
