Supporting Your Child's Learning

Our **Nursery** children have been given the challenge of making a **dragon** at home for **Chinese New Year**. We look forward to seeing your creations and hearing about how you have made your dragons.

Reception children are really enjoying sharing Traditional Tales. The Three Billy Goats Gruff is a particular favourite and lends itself to role play on our stage. It has also triggered some lovely writing and artwork. **Maybe read your child a Traditional Tale and experiment with using different voices and expressions?** We enjoy sharing any contributions via Tapestry in class.

Year One are buzzing with excitement as they learn about Rainforests around the world. The children are being challenged to learn vocabulary which accurately describes the climate in a Rainforest as well as the different species of animals found within them.

Parents can support this process by exploring the meaning of words such as 'humid', 'damp', 'moisture' and 'vegetation' and 'canopy'.

Can you find any other useful words and their meanings?

Year Two's learning about Space is well under way and they are preparing to write a non-chronological, non fiction piece of work. **Ask your child what this means and challenge them to explain some of the very impressive vocabulary they have been using this week, for example, 'celestial', 'lunar', 'clusters', 'steroids' and 'galaxies'.**
