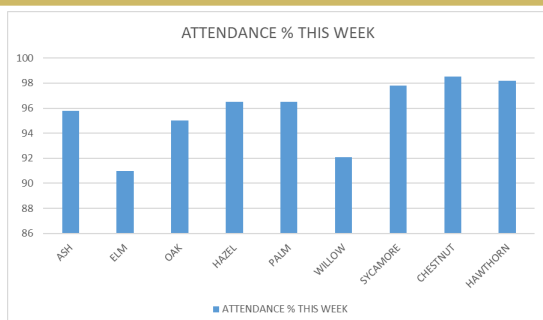
Nursery
