Oak Class are reading **The Gingerbread Man**

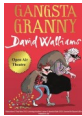


Palm Class are enjoying **One Hundred Steps** by Captain Sir Tom Moore

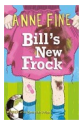


Willow Class are sharing **Matilda** by Roald Dahl.
