

What's Happening in Classrooms?

Nursery have been learning about where we live and the features of different types of homes. They are also enjoying the story of **The Colour Monster**- ask your child which feeling is represented by each colour.

Reception have had a very exciting week making their own homemade soup and bread rolls! This was prompted by sharing the story of 'Oliver's Vegetables'. Ask your child about their newfound cookery skills and what their soup and roll tasted like.

Year One's Enquiry theme is 'What's Cool About Our School'. Ask your child about 'past', 'present' and 'future' and the term 'long ago'. They have also been learning about the different features of our school and linking this to their work in Science on materials.

Year Two have travelled back in time in their Enquiry theme of 'Castles'. Ask your child what they know about the Tower of London. Can they remember it was built over 1000 years ago? Year Two have also been investigating the different properties of materials and have carried out an investigation using Malvern stone.
