Learning this half term

Y2 are learning about Space. So far they have watched the Peregrine Moon Lander launch into space on Newsround. We are sharing what we know and what we want to find about space travel and the planets. On 24th January we are looking forward to a virtual tour of our Solar System!

Y1 have started their new Enquiry 'Model Rednal'. We will be exploring the history of Longbridge and investigating how cars have changed over time. We will be using photos and videos to help us understand what life was like before cars! We will also be following and creating our own instructions on how to make a jam sandwich, See if they can follow them at home with help from a grown up!

EYFS- Reception are enjoying the story 'One Snowy Night'. We will be creating our first story map as a class to help us retell the story in sequence. We are going to learn about the animals that live in woodland and be able to describe what they look like and what they eat. **Nursery are reading the story of Dear Zoo** and will be learning to retell the story using Makaton signs. We will be making comparisons in sizes, using our number skills and writing our own letters to the zoo!
